

**Non-disclosures of personal data apply only to data disclosed from the Population Information System.**

Non-disclosures are personal and valid until further notice. You therefore do not need to renew non-disclosures, for example, when you move. You cannot submit telemarketing restrictions to the Population Information System, as no phone numbers are stored in the system.

Non-disclosure for direct marketing purposes

The data will not be disclosed for direct marketing purposes or for market and opinion surveys. The non-disclosure for direct marketing only applies to advertising received by post. Despite the non-disclosure, data can still be disclosed to scientific surveys and similar purposes.

Non-disclosure of customer register updates

The data will not be disclosed to companies that update their customer registers with data from the Population Information System (such as newspaper and magazine publishers). Your address will not be disclosed to any customer registers when this non-disclosure is in place. If your address changes, you should make sure that it is updated for the companies you want. The exceptions are banks, insurance companies and Veikkaus Oy, to which the data can be disclosed even if the non-disclosure is in place.

Non-disclosure of contact information

Contact information will not be disclosed to address services or contact information services. However, banks and insurance companies are entitled to access the information. The information is also disclosed in the case of statutory obligations, such as debt collection or estate inventory.

Non-disclosure for public registers

The data will not be disclosed for public registers. A public register is a list of specific persons, such as graduates from an educational institution.

Non-disclosure for genealogical research purposes

The data will not be disclosed for genealogical research purposes.

Privacy statement

The controllers for the Population Information System are the Digital and Population Data Services Agency and the State Department of Åland. Why is my personal data collected?

The information you enter on the form is entered into the Population Information System. The Population Information System is maintained to facilitate, implement and ensure society's functions and information services as well as the rights and obligations of its members. The maintenance of the Population Information System is a statutory task of the Digital and Population Data Services Agency. How long will my personal data be retained?

As a rule, the personal data entered in the Population Information System is stored permanently.

Will my personal data be disclosed to others?

Disclosure of data in the Population Information System is regulated by legislation. Personal data is disclosed to central and local government authorities for the purpose of carrying out their duties. Personal data may also be disclosed to individuals and entities where they need information to fulfil their rights or obligations, as well as for direct marketing, opinion and market research, address services, customer register updating, historical or scientific research or other similar purposes.

What are my rights?

You have the right to inspect and correct the data that pertains to you and is stored in the Population Information System free of charge. You can inspect and correct your data at dvv.fi/en/check-your-own-personal-details, by visiting our service location in person or by contacting the Digital and Population Data Services Agency. You can also prohibit the disclosure of your personal data for direct marketing, opinion and market research, customer register updating, public registers or genealogical research. You also have the right to prohibit the disclosure of your contact information as part of a contact information or address service or other similar data service. You can prohibit the disclosure of data at dvv.fi/tietojen-luovuttamisen-kieltaminen (in Finnish) or by notifying the Digital and Population Data Services Agency of the matter.

If you believe that your personal data has been unlawfully processed, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Office of the Data Protection Ombudsman.
