(A report on family relationships is usually needed in connection with estate inventories, and this also includes the person's child if the child is deceased. The Digital and Population Data Services Agency can carry out a report on family relationships if the child was registered in the population register. A separate fee is charged for a report on the family relationships of a child if the information cannot be included in the report on the family relationships of the parent.)

Additional information:

In the additional information field, you can order a report on the family relationships of an heir who is included in the order of succession concerning the main individual. The Digital and Population Data Services Agency can carry out the report on family relationships if the person has been registered in the population register. You can also use the additional information field to order life certificates for heirs. Indicate the name and personal identity code or date of birth of the person and whether your order concerns a report on family relationships or a life certificate. A separate fee is charged for the report on family relationships or life certificate if the information cannot be included in the report on the family relationships of the main individual.

You can order a report on the family relationships of a person from the Digital and Population Data Services Agency for the time period the person has been recorded in the population register or has been a member of a religious community. You can also order a report on family relationships for a time period starting after 1 October 1999 for a person who has been a member of the Evangelical Lutheran or Orthodox church.

You will need a report on the family relationships of the deceased person from the age of 15 until their date of death in connection with, for example, an estate inventory. In some cases, to be able to determine the heirs of the deceased person, you may also require a report on the family relationships of spouses, previously deceased heirs and persons who have renounced their right to the inheritance.

In addition to personal data, the report on family relationships will include transfers between parishes and the population register, any moves abroad and back to Finland, and details concerning the person's spouses and children. In some cases, details concerning the parents of the person are also recorded in the report on family relationships.

If you order a report on family relationships, it will be processed within four weeks. If your order is to be delivered by post, take into account the delivery time of the postal service.

The disclosed information must be necessary for the stated purpose (Sections 28(1) and 28(2) of the Act on the Population Information System and Certificate Services Provided by the Digital and Population Data Services Agency.). In connection with the creation of the report on family relationships, the following information is recorded in the Population Information System's monitoring file: object of the disclosed data, stated purpose, time and date of disclosure, and the information concerning the client who ordered the disclosed data.

REPORTS ON FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS ORDERED FROM OTHER SOURCES

Reports on family relationships from Evangelical Lutheran and Orthodox parishes

Evangelical Lutheran and Orthodox parishes issue reports on the family relationships of their members. If the person has been a member of an Evangelical Lutheran or Orthodox parish for their entire life, you can obtain the report on family relationships from their parish. In that case, it is not necessary to order a separate report on family relationships from the Digital and Population Data Services Agency. If the person was a member of an Evangelical Lutheran or Orthodox parish before 1 October 1999, you must always order the report on family relationships from the parish in question for the time period preceding that date.

Reports on the family relationships of persons who lived in the ceded territories

If you need to order a report on family relationships from an archive concerning or located in a ceded territory, contact the National Archives of Finland.

Reports on family relationships from abroad

If you a report on family relationships from Sweden, you can order it from the Swedish regional archives for the time period preceding 1 July 1991 and from Skatteverket for the time period after 1 July 1991.
